**AFFIRMATION OF BAPTISM**

Alleluia! Christ is risen.

All of us who have been baptized into Christ Jesus were baptized into his death. We have been buried with him by baptism into death, so that, just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we too might walk in newness of life.

**If we have been united with him in a death like his, we will certainly be united with him in a resurrection like his.**

Christ being raised from the dead will never die again;

**Death no longer has dominion over him.**

The death he died he died to sin, once for all,

**But the life he lives, he lives to God.**

Do you believe in Jesus Christ, the Son of God?

**I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord.**

**He suffered under Pontius Pilate,  
was crucified, died, and was buried.




